Professor Jeong Min Lee is currently Professor, in radiology department at Seoul National University Hospital. Professor Lee has published more than 470 scientific articles in international journals and is an esteemed member of the Editorial Board of several journals including Radiology, KJR, Cancer Imaging, and Liver Cancer. In recognition of his contributions to the field, Dr. Lee has been honored as a fellow of ESGAR, and and the International Society for Magnetic Resonance in Medicine (ISMRM). Furthermore, he is a distinguished member of The Korean Academy of Science and Technology and the National Academy of Medicine of Korea. Currently, Dr. Lee serves as the President of the Korean Society of Radiology and as Chair of the Educational Committee for the Asia-Oceanian Society of Radiology. In 2022, he received the prestigious RSNA Honored Educator Award for his exemplary educational efforts. Dr. Lee's primary research interests encompass MR imaging diagnosis of hepato-biliary and pancreatic diseases, multiparametric MRI for oncologic diseases, MR elastography, and image-guided tumor ablation. He has authored numerous influential papers on the diagnosis of liver and biliary cancers, dual-energy CT, functional MR imaging for oncologic diseases, and radiofrequency tumor ablation for liver cancers.
